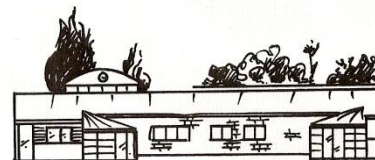

## School Uniform at Northleaze

I am really pleased to say that the vast majority of our pupils are very smartly dressed every day and wear their uniform with pride. Our policy on school uniform is based on the belief that it:

- promotes a sense of pride in our school
- helps to create a sense of community and belonging towards the school
- supports our commitment to inclusion
- prevents children from wearing 'fashion clothes' that could be distracting in class
- is practical, smart and designed with health and safety in mind

Please check your child's uniform against the requirements below:

### School uniform:

- White or royal blue polo shirt (plain or with school logo)
- Royal blue sweatshirt or cardigan (plain or with school logo)
- Grey trousers, skirt or pinafore dress (no black please and no leggings)
- Plain black shoes or trainers without obvious logos. ***If your child chooses to wear trainers as their school shoe, it is essential that they are fully black, not canvas material and can be cleaned.***
- White or grey socks or tights (no logo sports socks or trampoline centre socks please!)
- Blue and white summer dress in warmer weather (optional)

NB Year 6 wear a different uniform with a dark blue jumper and black or grey trousers or skirt

### P.E. Kit:

- Plain, house colour t-shirt (red for Ashton, blue for Brooke, green for Theynes and yellow for Yanley)
- **Plain** black or navy blue shorts, leggings or tracksuit trousers (no very tight fitting gym shorts please)
- Plimsolls (daps) or trainers
- School jumper and dark coloured tracksuit bottoms or leggings for outdoor games
- White, grey or navy socks (this is important if your child wears tights to school!)

### Jewellery and hair accessories

- Jewellery should not be worn to school due to health and safety guidelines and the risk of loss or damage. If children have pierced ears, then small studs only should be worn.
- For health and safety reasons and to ensure it does not distract from learning, we advise that long hair be tied back and that hair bands are simple items with no rabbit ears or deeley boppers! (Please save these for weekends and parties!)

Thank you very much for your support in this matter, school uniform is an important aspect of school life and helps to instil a sense of pride and belonging for the children.
