**As scientists:**

We are continuing our journey of learning about plants. We are going to be identifying and classifying garden and wild plants. We will also be researching the difference between Evergreen and Deciduous trees. We will then move on to looking at the difference between fruit and vegetables.

**As historian:**

We will be writing a journey story about our own imaginative object and retelling the stories in words and pictures as well.

We will be learning about:

**Multiplication and Division**

- Counting in 2s, 5s & 10s
- Comparing equal and unequal groups

**Fractions**

- Recognising a half
- Recognising a quarter

**Direction and Position**

- Using forward, backwards, above & below and left & right

**As computer scientists:**

This term's PSHE is all about relationships. We will talk about different types of families, our friendships and people who help us.

**As athletes:**
