Year 4 Curriculum Overview Term 3

As artists/designers

The children will be designing and creating (by sewing) their own money containers (wallet/purse).

As linguists:

In French we will continue to cover vocabulary to do with school and then move onto the home.

As mathematicians:

This term we will be looking at:

- 1. Multiplication and division B** – factor pairs, multiplying and dividing by 10 and 100, related multiplication and division facts, informal written methods for multiplications, multiplying and dividing a 2-digit number by a 1-digit number, multiplying and dividing a 3-digit number by a 1-digit number, correspondence problems and efficient multiplication.
- 2. Measurement: length and perimeter** – measure and equivalent lengths (km and m), perimeter on a grid, perimeter of a rectangle and rectilinear shapes, finding missing lengths and calculating perimeter of rectilinear shapes and the perimeter of polygons.

As computer scientists:

We will continue with our photo editing unit where they will learn how to spot fake images and then they will be combining their editing skills to create an advert for a place.

As musicians:

Charanga – Stop! - a rap/song about bullying. They will learn about the interrelated dimensions of music through games, singing and composing.
