**As scientists:**

We will be looking at **'living things and their habitats'** this term – finding out about vertebrates and invertebrates and learning how to classify each living thing based on their features.

**As historians:**

**RE**

**As linguists:**

**As artists and designers:**

**PSHE**

**As musicians:**

**As readers and writers:**
