In every Collective Worship we **'gather'** (listen to quiet music, light a candle and say 'Grace, mercy and peace be with you. *And also with you.*'); **'engage'** (tell a story, explore a theme etc., sing a hymn), **'respond'** (say a prayer/s) and **'send'** (leader says 'Go in peace to love and serve the Lord. *In the name of Christ, Amen.*'
