They are raising money for the Royal Navy Marines Charity and the money has been ringfenced for initiatives that support the mental health of submariners and their families. They fly out to the Canary Islands next week for the race start on 12<sup>th</sup> December and below is a picture of the boat 'Captain Jim' in which they will be for the entire race!



They hope to complete the race in under 40 days and the irony of leaving their families over the Christmas period to help support others is not lost on them.
