

Our Eco-Council spent a bit of a muddy yet fun afternoon yesterday helping the LANCE Trust plant some trees as part of their Great Hedge Creation project. Miss Reynolds, Year 1 Teacher, took the Eco-reps to nearby Yanley Lane to help Amanda Barrett from the Trust plant new hawtorn saplings, which form part of two kilometres of species-rich hedging that link up two parcels of local ancient woodland.
