Amen

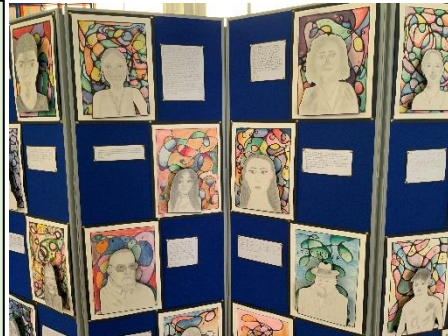
Art Extravaganza
