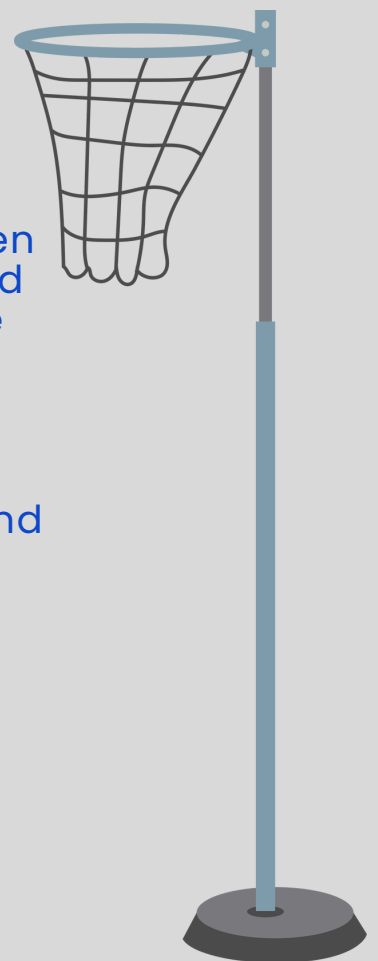


NETBALL CLUB

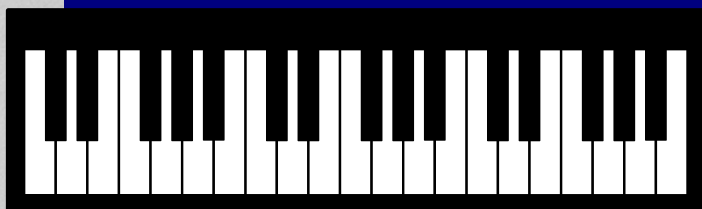
