MINDFULNESS MOMENT OF THE WEEK

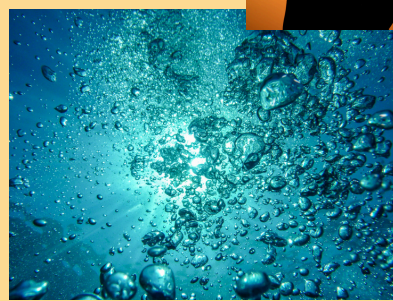


The mental wellbeing of all our children should always be a priority.

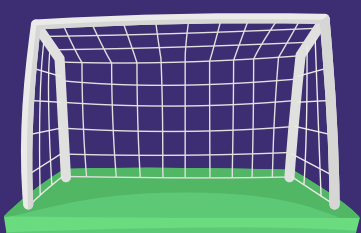
