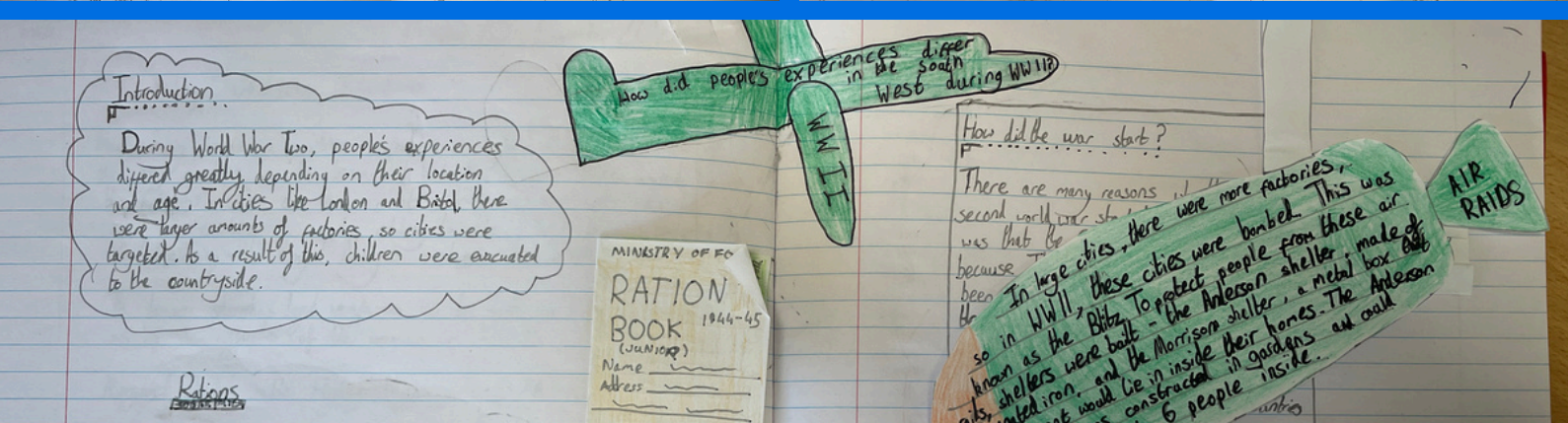
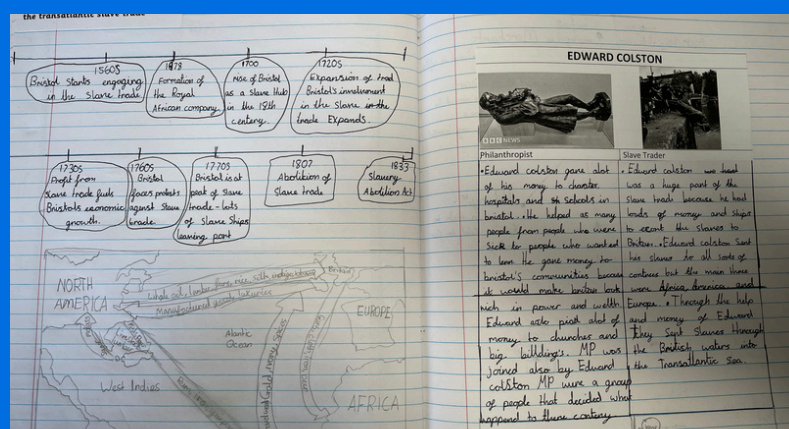
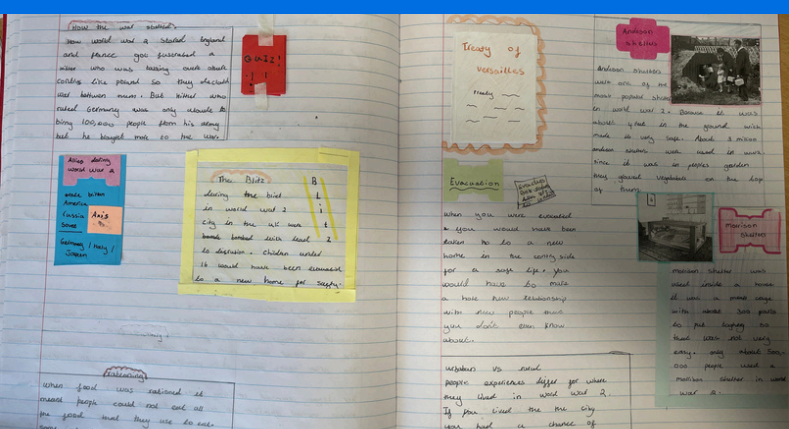
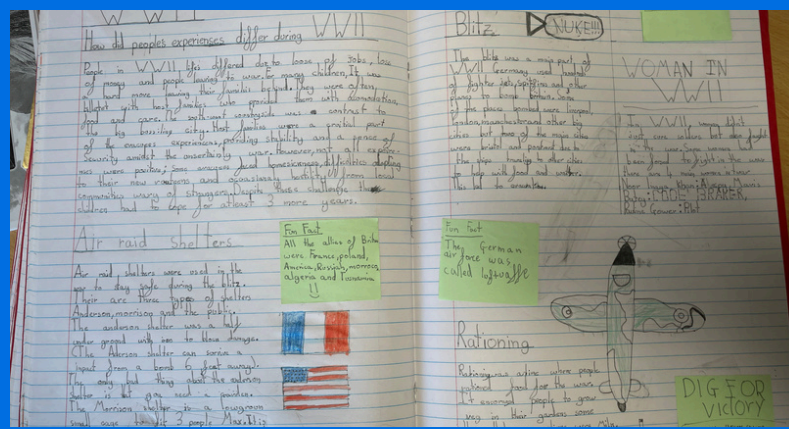
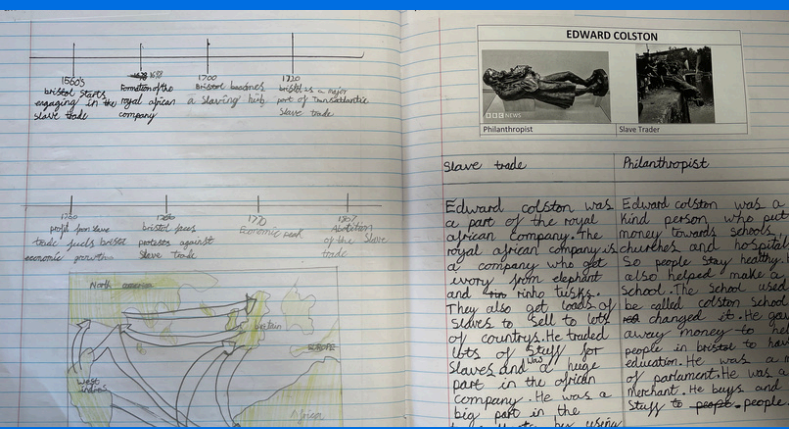


WELL DONE
