WORLD BOOK DAY

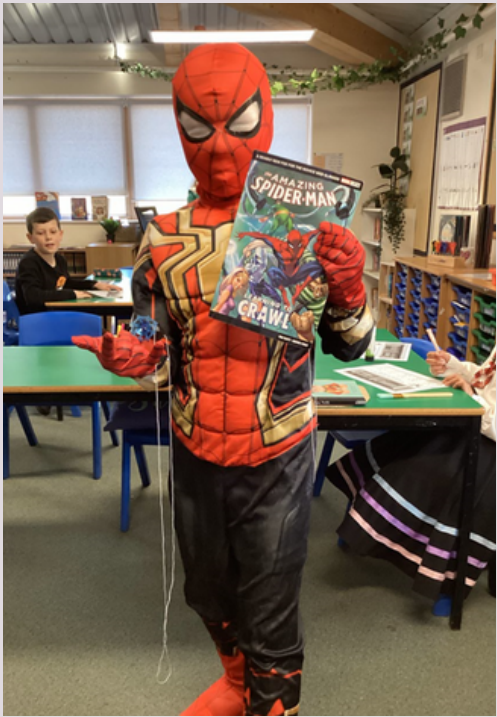


We had an amazing day last week celebrating World Book Day. The effort that you all put in to create some amazing costumes was so impressive!

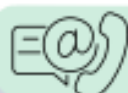
