



## Bible Story Spine Linked to our six Christian Values

This Bible Story Spine has been created to support our collective worship throughout the school year, aligning each term's Christian value with relevant stories from Scripture. Each story has been carefully chosen to reflect the value for that term and to connect with seasonal events, celebrations, and themes in our school calendar.

These stories will provide a foundation for worship planning, helping us explore how biblical teaching shapes our actions, attitudes, and relationships. By linking stories to our values—Responsibility, Creativity, Respect, Compassion, Resilience, and Friendship—we aim to deepen pupils' understanding of how these virtues can be lived out in daily life, encouraging reflection, discussion, and practical application.

### Autumn Term

Term 1 – Responsibility		
Bible Story	Values Link	Seasonal Link
<b>The Parable of the Two Sons</b> (Matthew 21:28–32)	This story emphasizes that actions speak louder than words true responsibility means doing what is right, not just saying it.	Beginning of the school year - setting expectations and personal responsibility.

<b>Noah's Ark</b> (Genesis 6–9)	Creative problem-solving in obedience to God.	National Road Safety Week—thinking about solutions.
<b>David and the Psalms</b> (Psalm 139)	Creativity in worship—music and poetry as praise.	Advent and Christmas preparation.
<b>Bezalel and Oholiab Build the Tabernacle</b> (Exodus 35:30–35)	Creativity in community—using gifts to serve others.	Advent—working together for celebrations.
<b>The Prodigal Son</b> (Luke 15:11–32)	Creativity in storytelling—Jesus use stories to teach deep truths.	Christmas—sharing stories of hope.

Term 3 – Respect

<b>The Lost Sheep</b> (Luke 15:1–7)	God’s compassion for the lost and vulnerable.	Spring—renewal and hope.

<b>Daniel in the Lions’ Den</b> (Daniel 6)	Daniel shows courage and resilience by staying faithful to God despite danger.	Summer term—encouraging pupils to stand firm in their values even when things feel challenging.
<b>Paul’s Shipwreck</b> (Acts 27)	Resilience in adversity—trusting God in storms.	Transition time—coping with change.
<b>Jesus in the Wilderness</b> (Matthew 4:1–11)	Resilience through prayer and faith.	Post-Easter—strength for the journey.
<b>Pentecost – The Coming of the Holy Spirit</b> (Acts 2: 1-13)	Pentecost shows how the disciples were strengthened and transformed by the Holy Spirit. When they felt unsure and fearful, God gave them courage, confidence and hope to continue Jesus’ work.	Preparing pupils for <b>change, transition and new challenges</b> Supporting emotional resilience, confidence and courage Linked to the Church’s mission and the growth of the early Christian community
